St. Petersburg-Clearwater International Airport is located on State Route 686 - Roosevelt Blvd. 4 miles north of St. Petersburg.

From St. Petersburg and Sarasota (the south, traveling north) - Use Interstate 275 North to reach the Airport. Take Exit 30 (686/Largo). Then, migrate to the left-most lane to use the overpass to Roosevelt Blvd. After the redlight, migrate again to the left-most lane and take the overpass to Ulmerton West 688. After two redlights, migrate to the right-most lane and take Roosevelt Blvd. West 686. The Airport is on the right.



From Clearwater - Take State Route 60 east (Gulf to Bay Blvd.) to the Bayside Bridge (which provides the most direct route from Safety Harbor as well via McMullen Booth Road). Take the first exit just south of the bridge and head east on SR 686 (Roosevelt Blvd.) for the airport.

From Tampa (the north approach, traveling westbound) - Use Interstate 275 across the Howard Franklin Bridge. Take Exit 31 (688 West) onto Ulmerton Rd. Travel 2.5 miles west. Then migrate to the right-most lane, West 686 (Roosevelt Blvd.) The Airport is on the right.

From New Port Richey and Pasco County (the north) - Take U.S. 19 south exiting at SR 686 east - Roosevelt Blvd for the airport.

Tampa International Airport is located just five miles west of downtown Tampa on the east shore of Tampa Bay.



From St. Petersburg and the West

Take Interstate 275 North to exit 39B and follow the signs to the airport entrance.

From the North

Take Interstate 75 South to Interstate 275 South to exit 39 and follow the signs to the airport entrance

From the South

Take Interstate 75 North to Interstate 4 West to Interstate 275 South to exit 39 and follow the signs.

From the East

Take Interstate 4 West to Interstate 275 South to exit 39.

From Spruce Street

Take any local road to Columbus Drive or Spruce Street and go westbound. The airport entrance is west of Westshore Boulevard.

From Highway 60

Highway 60 passes the airport entrance just east of the start of the Courtney Campbell Causeway. The airport entrance is well signed.

From the Veterans Expressway

The airport entrance is just south of the termination of the Veterans Expressway as you join Highway 60 eastbound.
